TWO FROM AUB RECEIVE AWARDS FOR WASTEWATER OPERATIONS

ATHENS, Tenn. – The Tennessee Water and Wastewater Association (TWWA) has awarded two Athens Utilities Board (AUB) employees prestigious awards for their work in the utility's wastewater operations.

At a technical meeting and awards ceremony held Thursday, Nov. 17, in Dayton, Tenn., TWWA named AUB's Randy Millsaps the 2005 recipient of the M.L. Brickey Award for his achievements overseeing maintenance operations for AUB's wastewater treatment plants and pumping facilities. The association also awarded Jill Davis, AUB Water and Wastewater Superintendent, with the James F. Pilkin, Jr. Collections System Operators Award.

Millsaps has been with AUB for nine years and is a certified treatment plant operator. The M.L. Brickey Award is given annually to an operator "for support of TWWA over and beyond the call of duty."

Davis joined AUB in 2001. The James F. Pilkin, Jr. Collections System Operators Award is given to a system operator or manager who has shown dedication to protecting the water supply.

Millsaps and Davis received the awards relative to their operations and oversight at AUB's Oostanuala Wastewater Treatment Plant and the Mouse Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant.
